

Important Information During Your Rental

Please read this carefully to ensure a safe and smooth trip:

Driving in Lofoten

Driving in Lofoten is beautiful, but requires attention:

- Roads are often **narrow and winding**
- Drive slowly and stay focused
- Be aware of:
 - cyclists
 - sheep (lambs) on the road
 - other animals

Always drive carefully and be prepared for sudden stops.

Parking

- Almost all parking areas are **paid parking**
- Some places have machines, but many require **payment through apps**

Important:

- If you receive unpaid parking tickets, these will be **invoiced after your rental + 10% handling fee**
- If a parking area is full, do not try to squeeze in
→ it's better to go somewhere else or come back later


Stopping on the Road

- Never stop on the road to take photos
- Even if it feels quiet, it is still considered a **main road (highway)**
- Always use proper parking areas

Accidents & Damage

If something happens:

- Always **fill out a damage report**
- Take photos of the situation
- Take a photo of the other driver's **driver's license**

 Important:

If you do not document the incident properly, you may be held **responsible for the damage** and the deductible cost.

Driving Area Restrictions

- You are **not allowed to drive outside Lofoten without prior approval**

This is due to:

- logistics
- insurance and handling of damages

 Important:

If something happens outside Lofoten without approval, you are **fully responsible for all costs** related to distance and handling.

Final Advice

- Take your time
- Plan ahead
- Respect local rules and nature
